

APIB Introduces Housekeeping Legislation

After almost five years of operation, the APIB (like most newly established Boards) has found limitations in the original enabling statute. Therefore, housekeeping legislation was approved by the Board at the January 23, 2018, Board Meeting. Representative Mooney has now introduced HB 327 and it has been assigned to the Boards and Commissions Committee. 1. “What This Bill Does” – This is a summary of the items and reasons for this legislation.
2. Amendments – Unfortunately, there were four errors in the original HB 327 as introduced on January 30, 2018. The amendments address each of those errors. It is important that amendments are read with HB 327. These amendments will be presented to the Boards and Commissions Committee to ensure all corrections to the Bill are made.
3. HB 327 – This is the entire Bill as originally read. This Bill includes the original errors, so please make sure the amendments page is read.
